RE: ADDENDUM NO. 1 TO THE TENDER NO. KP1/9AA-3/OT/55/15-16 - SUPPLY OF PROTECTIVE CLOTHING, EQUIPMENT AND MEASURED UNIFORMS.

Following the pre-bid meeting held in our Auditorium at Stima Plaza Nairobi on 8th July, 2016, and upon enquiry from prospective bidders thereat, and, at our own initiative we make the following clarifications and amendments to the Principal Tender Document (*hereinafter abbreviated as the PTD*) for Protective clothing and equipment 2016.
