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#### **FOREWORD**

This specification has been prepared by the Standards Department in collaboration with Human Resource Services Department; Safety, Health & Environment (SHE) Department of The Kenya Power and Lighting Company Limited (KPLC/Kenya Power) and The Kenya Electrical Trade & Allied Workers(KETAWU) .. The specification lays down requirements for Measured Uniforms. It is intended for use by Kenya Power in purchasing the items.

The offered product shall conform in all respects to high standards of engineering, design and workmanship and shall be capable of performing in continuous operation, in a manner acceptable to KPLC who will interpret the meaning of the drawings and specifications and shall have the power to reject any work or materials, which in their judgment, are not in full compliance with the specifications.

The supplier shall submit information which confirms manufacturer's satisfactory service experience with products which fall within the scope of this specification.

#### 1. SCOPE

- 1.1 This specification is for Measured Uniforms for use by Company Employees.
- 1.2 The specification covers the following categories/items:
  - Meter Reader's Set (Men, Ladies)
  - Kaunda Suit
  - Driver's Set (Men, Ladies)
  - Executive Driver's Set (Men, Ladies)
  - Tea Lady's Set
  - Artisan/Craftsman Set (Men, Ladies)(Blue jeans, polo tee-shirt)
  - Cook Uniform Set
  - Waiter/Waitress' Uniform Set
  - Receptionist Set
  - Cashier Set
- 1.3 The specification stipulates the minimum requirements for measured uniforms acceptable for use in the company and it shall be the responsibility of the Supplier to ensure adequacy of the design, adherence to applicable standards and regulations, good workmanship and good practice in the manufacture of the products for The Kenya Power & Lighting Company Ltd.
- 1.4 The specification does not purport to include all the necessary provisions of a contract.

#### 3. TERMS AND DEFINITIONS

3.1 The definitions given in the reference standards for each item shall apply.

(Swimming bath water).

3.2 Kenya Power Logo – As per sample available with the company's Human Resource & Administration (HR&A) Division.

#### 4. REQUIREMENTS

#### 4.1. Service Conditions

The uniforms shall be suitable for continuous use outdoors in the following tropical operating conditions:-

- a) Altitude up to 2,200m above sea level;
- b) Temperature: average of +30°C with a min of -1 °C and max +40°C;
- c) Humidity: up to 95%;
- d) Pollution: Design pollution level to be taken as "Heavy" (Pollution level III) for inland and "Very Heavy" (Pollution level IV) for coastal applications in accordance with IEC 60815;
- e) Isokeraunic level: 180 thunderstorm days per year;
- f) Tropical Sunshine conditions

#### 4.2. General requirements

(Applicable to all measured uniform items manufactured for The Kenya Power & lighting Company Ltd)

- 4.2.1 The uniforms (garments) shall be new and unused.
- 4.2.2 The items shall be manufactured from materials complying with Kenya Standard KS 541 or equivalent standard.

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- 4.2.3 The basic designs for various items shall be in accordance with Annex B attached to this specification and or as per the approved sample. Colours and marking (where required) shall be as per the designs and specified requirements for each item.
- 4.2.4 Each item shall be made from fibre-dyed fabric.
- 4.2.5 Sizes shall be as per the measurements taken by the successful supplier for each entitled employee after tender award. Standard sizes, where applicable, shall be in accordance with ISO 3636 and ISO 3637. The measurements/sizes shall provide enough allowance for comfort on the wearer
- 4.2.6 Pocket bag edges shall be sewn with double stitch (two rows of stitching).
- 4.2.7 Pockets, buttons and buttonholes shall be properly aligned and as per approved design.
- 4.2.8 Each item shall be supplied with open buttonholes whose edges shall have been sewn to avoid fraying and the ends shall be locked.
- 4.2.9 All buttons and sewing threads shall match the colour of the main fabric.
- 4.2.10 Buttons shall be attached to the garment with a minimum of 8 stitches and tacked with 4 stitches to lock the thread.
- 4.2.11 Seams, stitching, sewing threads, facings, buttons, fronts, closures and fasteners shall all conform to relevant Kenya Standards. The number of stiches (for each item) shall be 10-12 per inch (per 25.4mm).
- 4.2.12 All garments shall be finished to match the required patterns in respect to handle and appearance.
- 4.2.13 Each garment shall be well pressed, free from gloss, brushed off and free from loose threads and ends of thread.
- 4.2.14 Raw edges shall be finished by overlocking plus a securing stitch.
- 4.2.15 Each garment shall be free from hole, cut or tear.
- 4.2.16 Metallic parts when used in any garment shall be corrosion resistant.
- 4.2.17 Each item shall bear identification mark(s) comprising Kenya Power logo embroidered in a strategic position and sized as per approved design and or as per requirements specified for each item.

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- 4.2.18 Each item shall be subject to Sample & Design Approval by The Kenya Power & Lighting Company Ltd before manufacture. The supplier shall submit sample and design details for each item on order to The Kenya Power & Lighting Company Ltd for approval before manufacture.
- 4.2.19 The material for pockets and lining shall be 100% viscose

### 4.4. Particular Requirements

### 4.4.1. Meter Readers Set (Men, Ladies)

The Meter Readers Set shall comprise of:

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a) Men: One trouser, two shirts and one safari coat

b) Ladies: One skirt or trouser, two blouses and one safari coat

#### 4.4.1.1 Men

#### (i) Men's Trouser

- a) The colour shall be Pantone Blue 288C.
- b) Material of construction shall be 65% polyester and 35% cellulose.
- c) The trouser shall be straight in design, with two front/hip pockets, one right back pocket enclosed with button, two front gathers on each side, six belt loops, zipper fly with stainless steel metallic hook and button, matching blue thread stitching; all as per approved design/sample.
- d) The trouser pockets shall have a width of 14 for 72cm waist and under and 15 cm for 76 cm waist and over. The effective depth of the pockets shall not be less than 18 cm.
- e) The style of the front/hip pockets shall be a slanted pocket, called quarter-top- and French pocket.
- f) Back pocket, sometimes called besom pockets, shall be inserted on garment through a slash in shell fabric.
- g) The shield lining and fork lining shall be made from the main fabric, Knee lining and pocket bags shall be made of viscose..

#### (ii) Shirt

- a) The shirt shall be light blue pantone 657C in colour or white when stated in the tender.
- b) The material of construction shall be 65% polyester and 35% cellulose.
- c) The shirt shall be long sleeved, with cuffs, full collar, front buttons and one left chest pocket with a flap enclosed with a small button.
- d) The shirt shall have a front placket (button strip) with 7 buttons.
- e) The shirt shall have an embroidered Kenya Power logo measuring 40mm x 40mm centered on the upper left chest area above the pocket; all as per the approved design/sample.

#### (iii) Safari Coat

- a) The coat shall be blue pantone 288C in colour.
- b) The materials of construction shall be 65% polyester and 35% cellulose.
- c) The coat shall be sleeveless with no collar, have four front buttons and four front pockets all with buttoned and well aligned flaps. The back shall have a central seam with an overlapping cut at the bottom.
- d) The coat shall have inner lining made from viscose with one inner pocket on the left side.
- e) The coat shall have an embroidered Kenya Power logo in reflective yellow colour centered at the left chest area above the pocket. The overall dimensions of the logo at the front chest area shall be 65mm length and 65mm height.
- f) The coat shall also have 'Kenya Power' letters embroidered in reflective yellow colour centered at the back (as per approved sample). The overall dimensions of the marking at the back shall be 200mm length and 60mm height, with a tolerance of ±5mm; all as per the approved design/sample.

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#### 4.4.1.2 Ladies

#### (i) Ladies' Trouser

- a) The colour shall be Pantone Blue 288C.
- b) Material of construction shall be 65% polyester and 35% cellulose.
- c) The trouser shall be straight in design, with two hip pockets, five belt loops, one dart on each side both at the back and front, with a band (elasticized on both sides on user request), zipper fly with one button and matching blue thread stitching; all as per approved design.
- d) The shield lining and fork lining shall be made from the main fabric, pocket bags shall be made of viscose.

#### (ii) Skirt

- a) The colour shall be Pantone Blue 288C
- b) Material of construction shall be 65% polyester and 35% cellulose.
- c) The skirt shall have a waist band (elasticized on both sides on user request), four belt loops, one dart on each side at both the front and the back, overlapping slit at the back, zipper at the centre back with one button and ¾ length inner lining of 100% viscose; all as per approved design/sample.

#### (iii) Blouse

- a) The blouse shall be light blue pantone 657C in colour or white when stated in the tender.
- b) The material of construction shall be 65% polyester and 35% cellulose.
- c) The blouse shall be ¾ sleeved, full color, front buttons and one chest pocket on the left.
- d) The blouse shall have an embroidered Kenya Power logo measuring 40mm x 40mm centered on the upper left chest area above the pocket; all as per the approved design/sample.

#### (iv) Safari Coat

All requirements shall be as per clause 4.4.1.1 (iii)

#### 4.4.2. Kaunda Suit

- a) The suit shall be blue pantone 288C in colour
- b) Materials of construction shall be 65% polyester and 35% cellulose
- c) The top shall be short sleeved with turn-up, have five front buttons, collar and two chest pockets with buttoned flaps. There shall be an embroidered Kenya Power logo in reflective yellow colour centered at the left chest area above the pocket measuring 65mm x 65mm.
- d) The top shall have an inner lining made from viscose.
- e) The trouser shall be as per clause 4.4.1.1 (i)

#### 4.4.3. Driver's Suit (Men, Ladies)

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#### 4.4.3.1 Men

The driver's suit for men shall comprise: one coat, one trouser, two shirts and one tie.

#### (i) Coat

- a) The coat shall be blue pantone 288C in colour.
- b) Materials of construction shall be 65% polyester and 35% cellulose for shell and 100% viscose for lining.
- c) The coat shall be single breasted, fitting three button design, with padded lining in the shoulder area, reinforced collar, two inside pockets with a minimum width of 150mm and a depth of 150mm, one chest and two hip pockets with a minimum width of 120mm and a depth of 150mm (with flaps and pantone yellow 7406C coloured band) on the outside (all non-patched type) and double cut(vents) at the back.
- d) The coat will be fully lined with notch lapels.
- e) Each sleeve shall have three spaced buttons at the end.
- f) There shall be an embroidered Kenya Power logo 65mmx65mm centered at the left chest area on the pocket; all as per approved design/sample.

#### (ii) Trouser

All requirements shall be as per clause 4.4.1.1 (i)

#### (iii) Shirt

The QAP shall be based on and include relevant parts to fulfill the requirements of ISO 9001:2008.
- 4.5.2 The Manufacturer's Declaration of Conformity to reference standards and copies of quality management certifications including copy of valid and relevant ISO 9001: 2008 certificate shall be submitted with the tender for evaluation.
- 4.5.3 The bidder shall indicate the delivery time of the measured uniforms, manufacturer's monthly & annual production capacity and experience in the production of the type and size of measured uniforms being offered. A detailed list and contact addresses (including e-mail) of the manufacturer's previous customers for similar measured uniforms sold in the last five years as well as reference letters from at least four of the customers shall be submitted with the tender for evaluation.

#### 5. TESTS AND INSPECTION

- 5.1 Tests for the materials used and standard of manufacture shall be done in accordance with the relevant Kenya Standards, KS 541, KS 1469, KS 08-687 and the requirements of this specification. It shall be the responsibility of the Supplier to perform or to have performed all the tests specified.
- 5.2 Copies of previous Test Reports issued by a third party testing laboratory that is accredited to ISO/IEC 17025 shall be submitted with the tender for the purpose of technical evaluation. The accreditation certificate for the testing laboratory shall also be submitted with the tender.

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The test reports to be submitted with the tender for evaluation shall include material composition, standard of manufacture and properties (colour fastness and change in dimensions/shrinkage).

- 5.3 Every batch of measured uniforms shall be subject to inspection by Kenya Power staff at the place of manufacture and tests/inspection carried out on samples picked at random in their presence. Test reports shall be completed (by the manufacturer) and made available by the supplier to Kenya Power for approval before delivery of the items.
- 5.4 On receipt of the measured uniforms, Kenya Power will inspect them and may perform or have performed any of the relevant tests in order to verify compliance with the specification. The supplier shall replace without charge to Kenya Power, measured uniforms which upon examination, test or use fail to meet any or all of the requirements in the specification.
- 6.0 MARKING, LABELLING AND PACKING
- 6.1 Labels shall be attached to each garment and shall have the following information; marked legibly and indelibly:
  - name/trademark of manufacturer;
  - standard to which the garment complies;
  - size:
  - instructions for care and cleaning
  - Material details (Fibre composition)

The labels and marking shall be done at the factory during manufacture.

- 6.2 The measured uniform shall be dispatched by the supplier in clean condition and shall be supplied packed in such a manner as to avoid soiling and damage in transport and storage
- 6.3 Items required as a set shall be packed as so required.
- 6.4 Each package of each set/item shall be labeled with the name, staff number and station of the person whose measurements were taken.
- 6.5 Detailed user's instructions guide including washing guide and meaning of all symbols used shall be submitted with each item printed in English language.

#### **DOCUMENTATION**

- 7.1 The bidder shall submit its tender complete with technical documents required by Annex A (Guaranteed Technical Particulars) for tender evaluation. The technical documents to be submitted (all in English language) for tender evaluation shall include the following:
  - a) Guaranteed Technical Particulars signed by the manufacturer;

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- b) Copies of the Manufacturer's catalogues, brochures, drawings and technical data;
- c) Sales records for the last five years and at least four customer reference letters;
- d) Details of manufacturing capacity and the manufacturer's experience;
- e) Copies of required type test reports by a third party testing laboratory accredited to ISO/IEC 17025;
- f) Copy of accreditation certificate to ISO/IEC 17025 for the third party testing laboratory;
- g) Manufacturers letter of authorization, ISO 9001:2008 certificate and other technical documents required in the tender.
- 7.2 The successful bidder (supplier) shall submit the following documents/details to The Kenya Power & Lighting Company for approval before manufacture:
  - a) Guaranteed Technical Particulars signed by the manufacturer;
  - b) Design Drawings with details of the measured uniform to be manufactured for KPLC.
  - c) Quality assurance plan (QAP) that will be used to ensure that the design, material; workmanship, tests, service capability, maintenance and documentation will fulfill the requirements stated in the contract documents, standards, specifications and regulations. The QAP shall be based on and include relevant parts to fulfill the requirements of ISO 9001:2008
  - d) Detailed test program to be used during factory testing;
  - e) Marking details and method to be used in marking the Measured uniforms;
  - f) Manufacturer's undertaking to ensure adequacy of the design, good engineering practice, adherence to the specification and applicable standards and regulations as well as ensuring good workmanship in the manufacture of the Measured uniforms for The Kenya Power & Lighting Company;
  - g) Packaging details (including packaging materials).
- 7.3 The supplier shall submit recommendations for use, care, storage and routine inspection/testing procedures, all in the English Language, during delivery of the measured uniforms to KPLC stores.




