ADDENDUM NO. II TO THE TENDER NO. KP1/9A.2/OT/57/NM/18-19 FOR PROVISION OF ROADS/PAVEMENT OPENING/ CUTTING, DUCTING AND REINSTATEMENT SERVICES

The following clarifications are made to the specified provisions of the Tender document.

1. RELATIONSHIP WITH THE PRINCIPAL TENDER DOCUMENT

Save where expressly amended by the terms of this Addendum, the Principal Tender Document shall continue to be in full force and effect. The provisions of this Addendum shall be deemed to have been incorporated in and shall be read as part of the Principal Tender Document.

2. CLARIFICATIONS

The following responses are made to clarification sought on various issues in the tender document and shall be deemed to form the addendum;

1.	We are seeking advice on clarification of vehicles log Books ownership by KRA as required in the tender document. KRA claimed they do not issue clarification since they don't issue log books?	KRA do not issue log books but NTSA does. Where copies are submitted, they must be certified by commissioner of oaths.

2.	<p>On page 34 of the Invitation letter it talks about Tenderers submitting Audited Financial Statements reported within the past 18 months. Yet on page 44, it is asking for Audited Financial Accounts reported within the last 36 months:</p> <p>We are therefore left wondering which one is the correct version or requirement that we should follow.</p>	<p>Audited Financial statements must be those that are reported within 3 years (36) calendar months of the date of the tender document.</p> <p>Bidders whose companies or firms were registered or incorporated within the last two calendar years of date of tender document should Refer to Addendum 1 – No 2 (a) (ii).</p>
3.	<p>During the pre-bid meeting, it was mentioned that no 2 companies should bid for these works if at all their owners are related, the Question is, how far is such relation go back:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Brother/Sister Father/Mother Father/Son Father/Daughter Mother/Daughter Mother/Son Cousins <p>Or just general relatives?</p> <p>However, in relation to above, it should be taken into account that these are independent Kenyans (as CR12 will indicate) running their own businesses like any other and who feel entitled to place a tender with your organization.</p>	<p>Bidders are required to refer to Section III (Appendix to instructions to tenderers No 1 (Eligible tenderers)</p> <p>“Directors in one Company should not be associated in any other bidding Company within this tender”</p>
4.	<p>In the submission checklist you have provided the page numbers, does this mean we should ensure the documents lie on the indicted pages this is very unclear to us</p>	<p>The column on page numbers is a guide to the bidder on the location of the particular item in the Tender document.</p>
5.	<p>While selecting the FBBU or the area to work in, are there work categories like (a) new u/g cables installations and (b) Maintenance and emergencies u/g cables breakdowns?</p>	<p>There are no job categories in this particular tender. Whoever is awarded the contract in a FBBU/area will be doing all those jobs. Remember each bidder is supposed to select only one FBBU/area out of 25 in this tender.</p>
6	<p>There are some provisions which talk of law firms hence wondering their roles e.g. 3:28.3 and 3:29.4-c while in respect of 3:23,3:24 are missing but are quoted in the next provisions.</p>	<p>The omitted clauses in Section II under 3.2 (Eligible tenderers) shall be as detailed below;</p> <p>3.2.3 Collusion or Agreements between eligible tenderers to directly or indirectly fix prices or any other trading conditions is prohibited. Where this is discovered, the tenderers involved will not be eligible for award and shall be disqualified.</p>

		<p>3.2.4 Notwithstanding any other provisions of this tender, the following are not eligible to participate in the tender: -</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">a) KPLC's employees, its Board or any of its committee members.b) Any Public/State Officer of the Government of the Republic of Kenya (GoK).c) Any member of a Board or Committee or any department of GoK.d) Any person appointed to any position by the President of Kenya.e) Any person appointed to any position by any Cabinet Secretary of GoK.f) Any tenderer submitting false, inaccurate or incomplete information about their qualifications.

The tender closing date has been extended from 26th June 2019 to **10th July 2019** at 10.00 am.

All other terms and conditions remain as per the Principal Tender Document (PTD).
