The above tender refers.

Following the pre-bid on 2^{nd} December, 2020 we make the following clarifications and amendments to the principal tender document (hereinafter abbreviated as the PTD) for the Supply of Personal Protective Clothing and Measured Uniforms.

5.	Some items have multiple specifications and have conflicting requirements. Eg. The overalls have two specifications uploaded.	Specifications to use, are as per the attached list. APPENDIX 1
6.	Advice on detailed specifications for Live line employees safety shoes.	Use specification KP1/6C.1/13/TSP/01/010-2 the shoes should be the ones with Non-metallic toecaps and inserts which is captured in 4.3.2.2.5.2 and 4.4.2.1.2.4 (b) They use the short safety shoe, not the army boot.
7.	Is there a difference between a boot oil resistant and boot Army oil resistant?	No. This is one shoe, difference is on shoe size.
8.	We did not find the specifications for the live line employees	Uploaded in the system.
9.	The award will be per lot or per item?	The award criteria is item by item to the lowest evaluated bidder.
10.	Can you provide a physical sample for us to compare against?	No. Kenya Power does not give samples. Bidders are to submit their samples as per the specification,
11.	Do you allow VAT flexibility because today it is 14% and might change by next year	Kenya Power uses the prevailing tax rate.
12.	Time given to respond to the tender is very limited. Especially for the measured uniforms which have to be taken to KEBS for sample approval. It takes 2-3 weeks to get the approval.
