2.0	<ul> <li>The project is funded by AFD and is in four lots.</li> <li>The project is similar to the ongoing Last Mile project, albeit in a reduced extent. It will basically involve installation of single phase distribution transformers on the 11KV and 33KV lines near a cluster of customers and the erection of Low Voltage reticulation to serve them.</li> <li>Bidders are encouraged to bid for the number of lots they can manage to deliver on time, although the bid documents do not limit the number one can be bid for.</li> <li>Those intending to bid for this project and have been awarded other projects by KPLC should ensure that they have completed 50% of their contracted works to avoid work overload and to enable them to complete the new works without delays.</li> <li>The works shall be awarded on turnkey basis and the time to completion shall be twelve months.</li> </ul>
