#### INTRODUCTION

#### **OPENING REMARKS**

Earthing will be done by bidder upon kplc supervision.bidde3r to factor in unit rates for earthing based on an assessment of a competent substation design engineer actuals will be derived during execution after geotechnical and soil investigations

The works are being undertaken in a green field area and thus there will preliminarily works for survey, geotechnical, and bidders will be responsible for the scope
