<u>RE: SENSITIZATION OF SUPPLIERS ON THE NEED TO REGISTER IN THE ELECTRONIC</u> GOVERNMENT PROCUREMETN SYSTEM

Reference is made to circular referenced NT/PPD/1/3/14Vol.VI (46) from National Treasury dated 30th May 2025 on the above subject matter. Through the circular, the National Treasury wishes to inform Suppliers as follows: -

The National Treasury is rolling out an end-to-end Electronic Government Procurement (e-GP) system to all Procuring Entities in both the National and County Governments. This is one of the Public Finance Management Reforms that is geared towards efficiency and value for money in the Public Procurement. The e-GP system rollout is in line with the directive by His Excellency, the President in his State of Nation address on 21st November 2024 that the National Treasury rolls out the e-GP system by the first quarter of 2025.

Suppliers/Contractors are required to self-register on the e-GP portal that is accessible through <u>www.egpkenya.go.ke.</u> In addition, they are requested to note the following:

- 2. Suppliers/Contractors/Consultants within Nairobi may visit e-GP offices situated on 6th Floor, Room 622 Treasury Building, Harambee Avenue to receive registration assistance between 9.00am – 4.00pm.
- 3. Supplier/Contractors/Consultants may also visit the National Treasury desk in all Huduma Centres during the office working hours;
- 4. Supplier registration module manual is available on the e-GP portal;
- 5. The National Treasury will organize weekly supplier registration webnar every Thursday. Suppliers will be required to register for training through links provided on <u>www.egpkenya.go.ke</u> under Supplier Training. Only supplier who have registered for training will be invited to the webinar.
- 6. That from 1st July 2025, all government procurement will be through the e-Government procurement System and registration of Suppliers is a prerequisite.

The purpose of this post, therefore, is to bring to your attention the communication from the National Treasury and request you to comply with the directive by registering on the e-GP portal.
